Mentor-mentee pair develops a **strong personal relationship** that positions that mentoring relationship to thrive in high school and college

Mentor-mentee pair **deepens and personalizes the student's post-secondary education plan** and pathway to that student's highest career aspiration

Student develops the college knowledge, skills, and mindsets needed to succeed in college and career

Student effectively navigates the college process

Mentor-mentee pair feels a **connection to the broader iMentor community** and engages in iMentor initiatives beyond the pair relationship
